EAH plans are gaining popularity because they make an employer stand out from the crowd, enhance recruitment efforts, and can have a positive impact on the bottom line. With an EAH plan, employees can realize a financial gain for their company as they help their employees achieve the dream of homeownership. EAH benefits are simple to administer, low in cost to offer, and can help you recruit and retain valuable employees, thus creating a positive impact on your company's bottom line.

EAH can work to build your dreams. As Antigua & Barbuda's most comprehensive home provider, we are working with employers throughout Antigua & Barbuda to create custom EAH benefit plans for employers who want to offer cutting-edge benefits that will make them stand out from the crowd.

HOW DOES EAH WORK? (CONT'D)
First, an employer undergoes underwriting and originates, and manages the relationship with the employer. Kervellent works with the employer, helping them create an EAH plan and identify lenders and other partners.

Although EAH is used mostly to help an employee buy a home, the employer also can offer an EAH benefit to help the employee with rental housing. Usually, a rental EAH benefit is structured similar to a financial EAH for homeownership except the eligible use of proceeds to help pay the security deposit or the monthly rent.

Kervellent started its own EAH program in 2004, offering a forgivable loan to eligible employees. Employees who receive an EAH benefit generally will get help with at least one of the three primary obstacles to homeownership:

- down payment
- closing costs
- information about completing the home-buying process

There are several standard EAH options. Employers generally provide funds to the employees, which are often used for portions of the down payment, closing costs, or a permanent interest-free loan on the employee's first mortgage. Some standard options include:

GRANT
This is a one-time engagement for the employer. The employer may require the grant to be repaid if the employee leaves before a specified period of employment.

FORGIVABLE LOAN
The employer makes a second loan to the employee at the same time as the first mortgage loan is originated. The lender on the first mortgage loan may facilitate the making of the employee loan. Some or all of the principle is forgiven at a specified rate over a specified period of employment.

DEFERRED OR REPAYABLE LOAN
A deferred or repayable loan functions the same as a forgivable loan, except there is a repayment feature, either immediately or at a specified time in the future.

MATCHED SAVINGS
The employer typically works with a counseling agency or lender to provide information to employees about buying a home. The employer can provide on-site facilities, or allow paid leave time. Counseling provides loan closing. Home-buyer education is a benefit that can help an employer learn how to improve his or her credit and help them better understand the home-buying process.

HOW DO EACH PLAN ADDRESS BUSINESS NEEDS?

Generally, the employer partners with a housing agency that, for a minimal fee, will offer working a six to eight-hour home-buyer education class plus one-on-one counseling. This may be on-site and possibly during working hours to make it easier for employees to participate.

Often an employer will also give the employee a day off for loan closing. Although the recruitment and retention results from this type of EAH is not as strong as a financial EAH, a home-buyer education EAH benefit can be very effective too.

Cricket Stops

Wet Guyana

CME responds to Premier's appeal to waive Guyana's broadcast fees for the West Indies Cricket Board. Barbados, CME - Fred Clarke, chief operating officer of the Caribbean Media Corporation, has responded to a letter of appeal from well-known regional sports personality Joseph 'Toke' Thomas to waive Guyana's required fees for coverage of regional and international cricket this year. Clarke informed Thomas that he had considered and was unable to find any precedent within the CMC or its shareholders where broadcast rights had been waived to any extent. "As you are aware, Guyana, Jamaica and the Cayman Islands have suffered due to the state of disaster during 2004, any attempt to give any consideration for a waiver of rights fee would have to be given to those markets as well, where contracts have already been signed for the same cricket package," Clarke wrote in a letter to Thomas. "This would mean a great financial difficulty, as it would require us as the CMC to pick up a substantial amount of the production costs. As you are aware, our main source of revenue for these events comes directly from the audience, and therefore to waive any fee to a participating nation would require that the other nations pick up the costs." Clarke's letter, this Premier's, was copied to Guyana's Prime Minister, Keith Mitchell, who has had responsibility within CARICOM for cricket, as well as to Barbados Prime Minister, Owen



Archie, and officials of the West Indies Cricket Board, the Guyana Cricket Board, and Caribb Hockey, sponsors of the West Indies first-class championship. Premier had appealed to Clarke for the waiver in a letter that read: "The CMC would have no problem with an approach by yourself to seek support from the other nations to have CMC waive the rights fee, for attending the production and increasing the cost on their side, so that the National Communication Network can benefit," Clarke wrote. "The other approach you may wish to consider is to have the nations agree to have CMC find a sponsor to cover your cost, and they donate output for the sponsorship. This is also available." Clarke also noted that the management of NCM has sought to publicly undermine the CMC by conducting investigations about the news cost of cricket and the role of this organization in the process. "It is in this context that I find your correspondence to be rather sensitive, as you did not copy the same organization, which you seek to assist," he wrote. "You are aware that in the past, our rights have been violated by those upon whom we have provided. Cricket rights were illegally provided from off-screen commentary, although rights fees had not been paid." Clarke concluded that the CMC remained committed to providing

to services in the region at the most off-site facility prices. "We are mandated to continue to improve our quality output to international standards and we will continue to work with all involved in this process," he said. CMC has audio and television broadcast rights for the First of the Caribbean Super Series, and the semifinals and Final of the West Indies limited-overs championship. It also holds audio broadcast rights for the West Indies tour of Sri Lanka and Australia later in the year.

Knowles and Nestor advance at Open-13 event

BARCELONA, France, CMC - Mark Knowles, of The Bahamas, and the Canadian veteran Daniel Nestor, are through to the semi-finals of the men's doubles at the US\$65,972 Open 13 tournament. The top seeds and world number one ranked Knowles and Nestor got past American John Knowles and Peter Lee, of the United States, 6-3, 6-4 in their quarter-final match on Thursday as they try to reverse the moderate results they have had so far this year. Knowles and Nestor, the reigning US Open doubles champions, had conquered the French pair of Sebastien Dechaume and Jean-Rene Liand in straight sets to get to the quarter-finals and are now on course for their first ATP of the year. At last month's Australian Open, the pair, who were champions at Melbourne in 2002, suffered a shock first round exit, a week after they had also made a hairy departure from the pre-qualifiers Open 13 doubles tournament at Sydney in the Open 3 main draw. Knowles and Nestor will face the winner of Friday's quarter-final match between John Benn Hinch and Andy Pan, and Nicholas Pietrangeli and Paulson Satchidan.

Meanwhile, in the men's singles, Greg Bourneville was forced to withdraw on Thursday early in his play. The British number two had been scheduled to play French qualifier Sebastien Chretien, who lost world number five Guillermo Costa 6-4 7-5 in round one. CMC 10/05

Stewed Pork with Dumplings
1 pound pork especially lean parts
1 onion
Salt, pepper, cherry tomatoes from the garden
Tomato paste
Margarine
Cooking Oil to fry
Chive and thyme
(Brown sugar burnt to make coloring)

Method
Heat dousing pot. Wash pork with lime. Dry in a clean towel and cut in pieces. Cut up onion and tomatoes. Heat a little oil or margarine. Cut pork in pieces and fry until brown. Pour off excess fat. Add the rest of ingredients fry. Stir well. Add enough water to cover meat and cook until tender.

Make dumplings
1lb flour
Dash of salt
1 tsp baking powder

Mix ingredients together. Add water and mix to a stiff dough. Knead well. Cut in pieces and make round or long dumplings. Place dumplings in the pot with the pork, allow to cook until meat and dumplings are thoroughly cooked. A piece of hot pepper can be added for the older persons after taking out for the children.

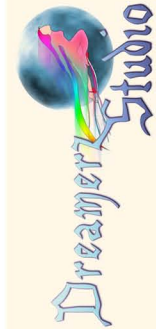

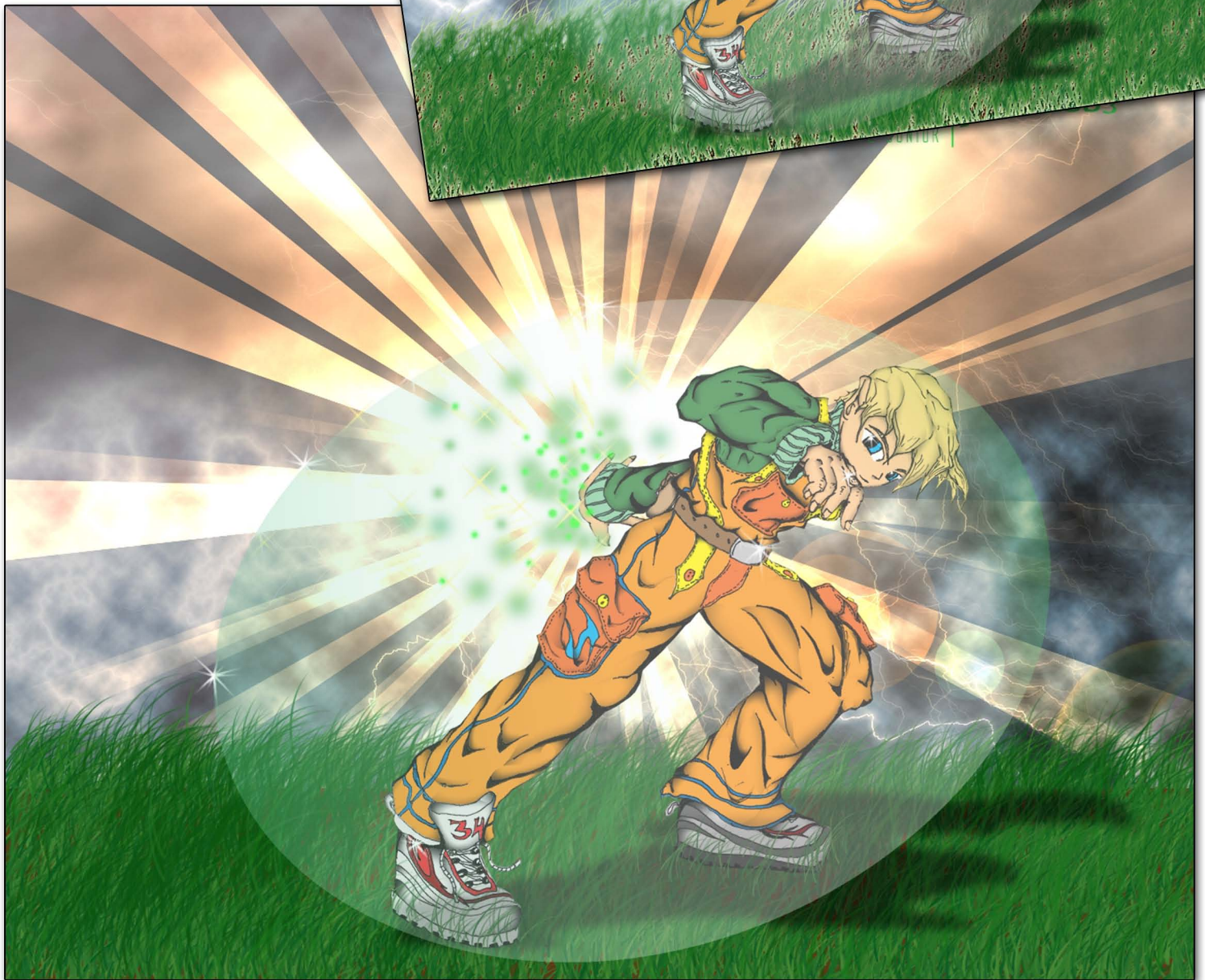
